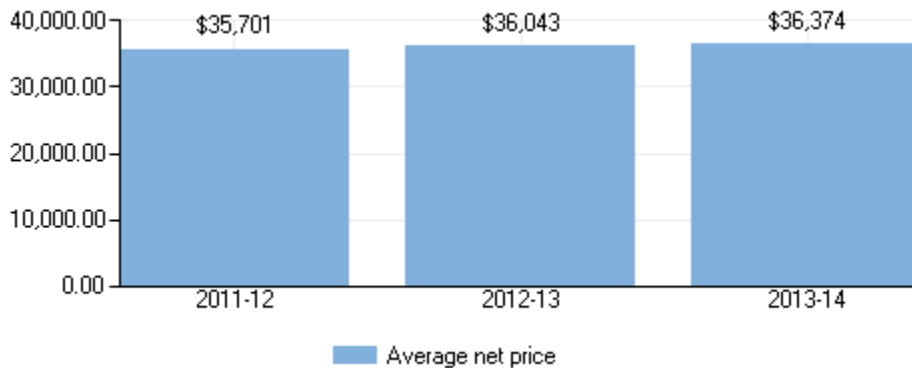

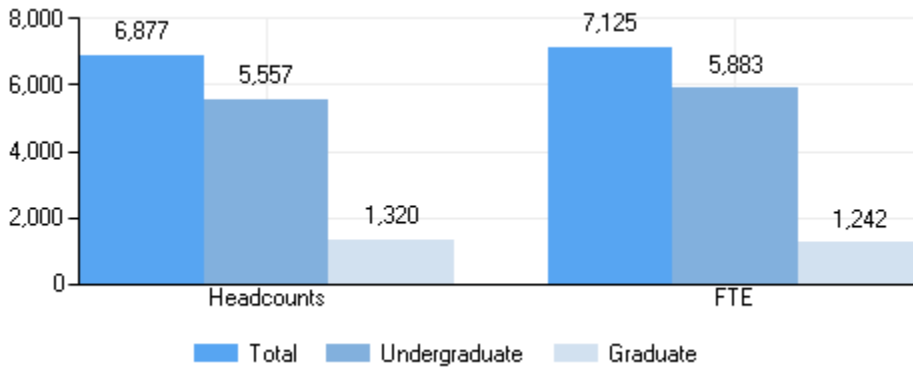

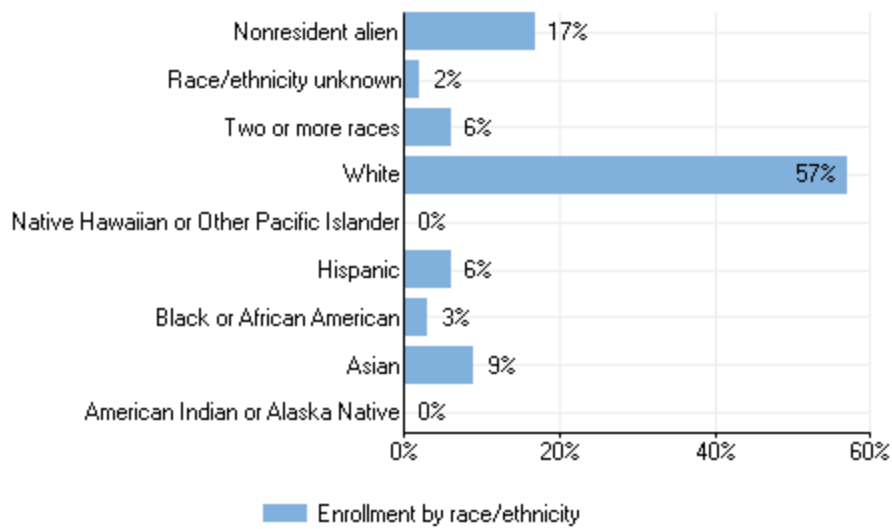
### Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2013-14



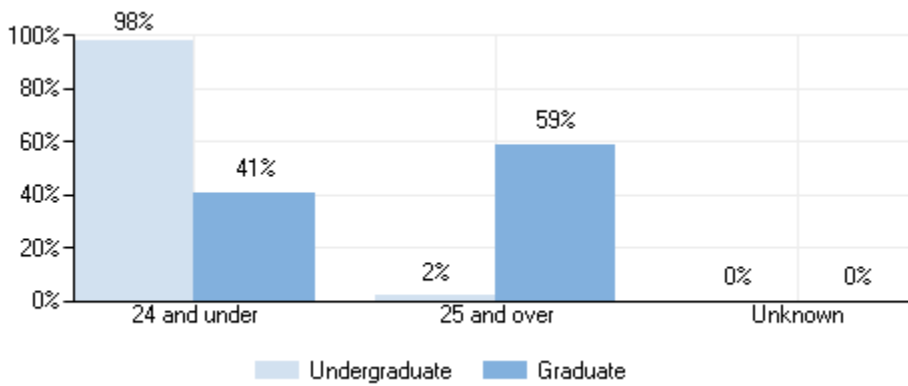

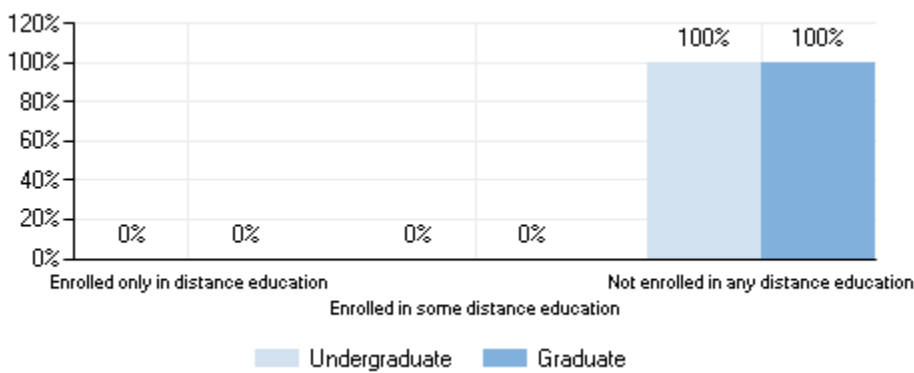
### Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2014



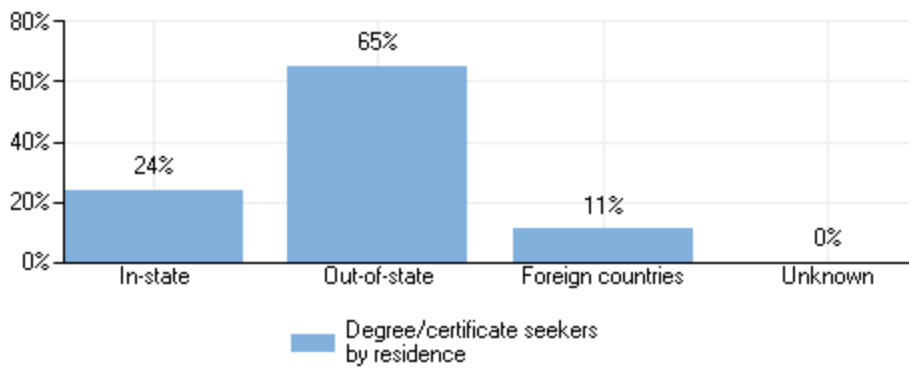
**Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2014**



**Enrollment by distance education: Fall 2014**

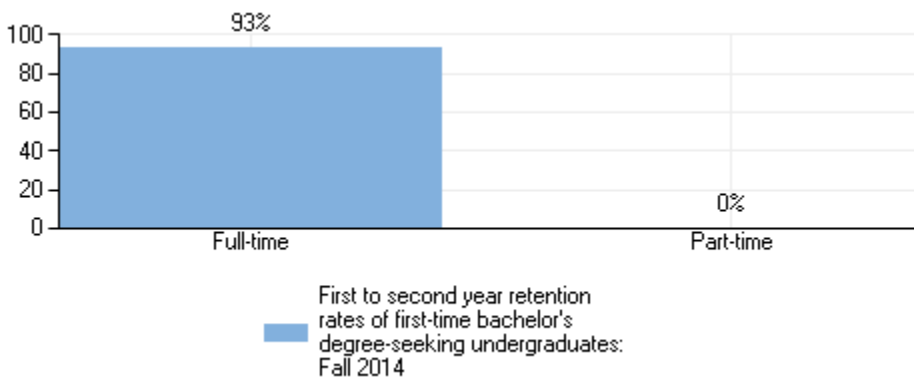


**Residence of first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2014**

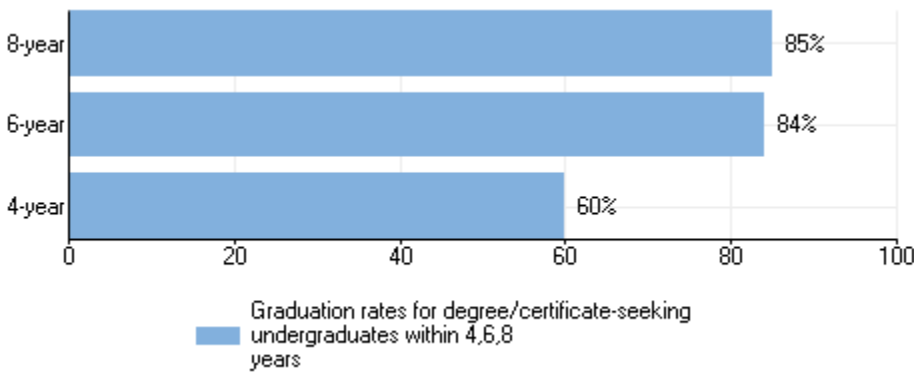

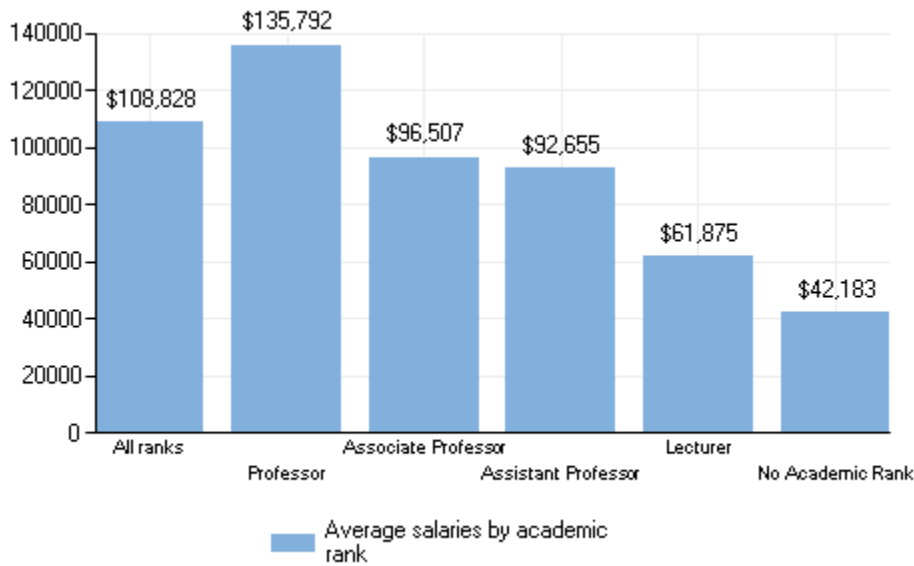

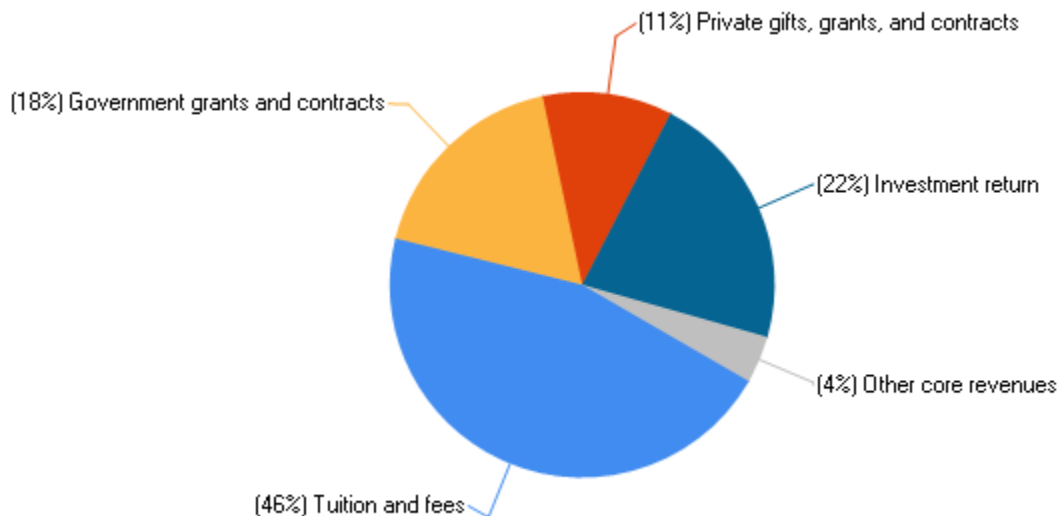

**Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2014**

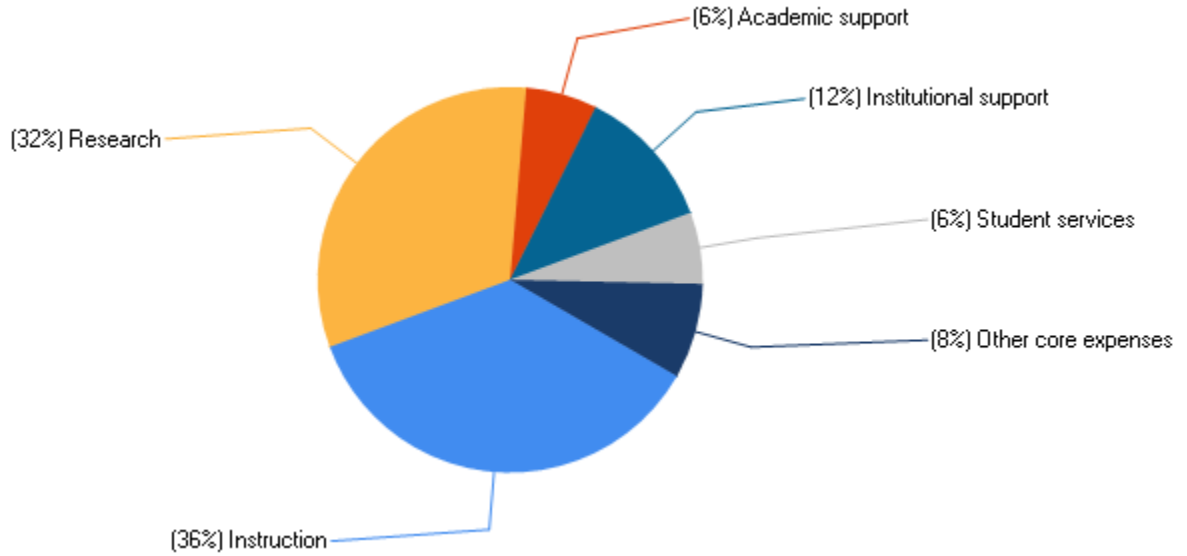




### Core revenues per FTE enrollment, by source: Fiscal year 2014
